

SEEDING PROCEDURES FOR ARKANSAS JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS

Arkansas Level 1

Use the latest Southern Level standings at the time of deadline.

Arkansas Level 2 and 3

Use the latest Southern Level standings at the time of deadline.

Arkansas Level 4

This level will use a combination method depending on latest standings of players in the tournament.

All players entered who are in the top 500 in the South will be given priority seeding based on their latest Southern standing over their AR standing. If a player's standing is below 500, the tournament shall then revert to the latest Arkansas standing.

There will be some tournaments in which some players seedings will be based on Southern standings and some based on Arkansas standings.

Southern standing will remain #1 priority. Example:

Player A	Southern standing	433	AR standing	24
Player B	Southern standing	481	AR standing	23
Player C	Southern standing	512	AR standing	19
Player D	Southern standing	519	AR standing	17

In this scenario, Player A will be seeded #1, Player B #2, Player D #3, and Player C #4.

Notice that Player A is seeded ahead of Player B because his Southern standing is higher. Since they are both inside the top 500, Southern standing takes first priority. Notice that Player D is seeded ahead of Player C because their Southern standing is below 500 which then reverts the seeding process to the Arkansas standings.

Arkansas Level 5 (Novice)

This level will use the latest Arkansas Novice standings at the time of deadline.
